26	providing the same service are located at an exit, a separate sign panel must be installed for that service." and inserting in
28	its place the following: 'Logos for 2 or more types of service may be displayed on the same sign panel. More than one logo sign
30	panel may be installed at an exit only when 3 or more qualified businesses are available for each of 2 or more types of service.
32	The number of logo sign panels at an exit may not exceed one for each type of service or a total of 4 for all types of services.'
