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### An Act to Authorize Casco Bay College to Grant Degrees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. P&SL 1973, c. 107 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

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Sec. 1. Associate of Science degree. Casco Bay College may confer Associate of Science degrees upon all who satisfactorily complete the courses of instruction as the directors of the corporation may from time to time prescribe.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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Casco Bay College is currently limited to offering Associate of Science degrees in several specific subject areas. This bill expands Casco Bay College's authority to grant degrees by permitting the college to grant Associate of Science degrees in whatever subject area its directors may prescribe.

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This bill also acknowledges the change in the name of the school, which occurred in 1974, from Plus Gray's School of Business to Casco Bay College.

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
