COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 760, L.D. 1872, "Resolve, to Secure a Release of Property from the State"

Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Authority to convey land. Resolved: That the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands may convey and release the State's interest for an amount not to exceed \$12,240 in the following property subject to acceptance by Rosalia Arlt:

Certain parcels of land, situated in the Town of Richmond, County of Sagadahoc, State of Maine, and identified as Tax Map R-6, Lot 67 and Lot 68.'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Conservation will incur some minor additional costs to convey the State's interest in a particular piece of property. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources. The Bureau of Parks and Lands within the Department of Conservation will realize

2 additional dedicated revenues in fiscal year 1996-97. The exact
amount can not be determined at this time, but it will not exceed
4 \$12,240.'

6 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

8 This amendment replaces the resolve and establishes a dollar
amount, not to exceed \$12,240, for the conveyance of certain
10 parcels of land situated in the Town of Richmond. The amendment
also clarifies the tax map lots of the property and adds a fiscal
12 note to the resolve.
