STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve authorizes the release of the State's interest in a parcel of land that escheated to the State when the owner died intestate, with no known heirs, in 1960. Subsequently, in 1965, the property was purchased by the Arlt family from the Town of Richmond. However, there has never been any legislative action taken regarding the transfer of this property. Thus, this resolve is necessary to quiet title to the property.
