This amendment provides General Fund appropriations of \$11,325 and \$49,215 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively, for an Education Program Coordinator - Construction position.

The amendment does not affect the net savings of the Productivity Realization Task Force, but will reduce the projected increase of the unappropriated surplus generated by the bill.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The productivity plan of the Department of Education reorganized the former Division of School Business Services and eliminated positions related to school construction. This amendment establishes an Education Program Coordinator - Construction position to provide continued technical support to school administrative units in the area of school construction.
