Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 6 statement of fact the following: 8 **'FISCAL NOTE** 10 1996-97 12 **APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS** 14 16 Other Funds \$177,562 18 REVENUES 20 Other Funds \$184,042 22 The delay of the repeal date of the Salmon Aquaculture 24 Monitoring and Research Fund to July 1, 1997 will increase dedicated revenues collected by the Department of Marine Resources for the fund by \$184,042 in fiscal year 1996-97. The 26 department will require an allocation of \$177,562 in fiscal year 28 1996-97 to reflect the delay of the sunset repeal date. Allowing the Commissioner of Marine Resources to make 30 additional expenditures in certain situations from the Salmon Aquaculture Monitoring and Research Fund may result in increased 32 expenditures from the fund in fiscal year 1996-97.
