COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1371, L.D. 1879, Bill, "An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$16,500,000 to Investigate, Abate and Clean Up Hazardous Substance Discharges, to Clean Up Tire Stockpiles and to Close and Clean up Municipal Solid Waste Landfills"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost of sending this bond issue out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the Second Regular Session of the 117th Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

If approved by the voters, the total cost of this bond issue is estimated to be \$21,173,625 with principal payments of \$16,500,000 and interest payments of approximately \$4,673,625.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. It adds a fiscal note to the bill.
