20	The extension of the milk handling tax for 15 months will increase General Fund revenue by \$3,150,000 in fiscal year
22	1996-97 and \$1,920,000 in fiscal year 1997-98.

26	this tax. These costs can be absorbed within existing resources.
28	The Department of Human Services will also incur some minor additional costs to cover the effect of higher milk prices on the
