12 This amendment reduces the General Fund appropriation to the Rainy Day Fund program to \$3,900,000; it eliminates the \$1,800,000 deappropriation from the General Purpose Aid for Local Schools account; it eliminates the authorization to transfer any available year-end appropriations from the General Purpose Aid for Local Schools account to the Rainy Day Fund program; and it eliminates the prohibition on fiscal year 1995-96 transfers from the General Purpose Aid for Local Schools account.
