HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1392, L.D. 1893, Bill, "An Act to Conform the Maine Tip Credit to the Federal Tip Credit"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §664, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Preparatory work. If an employee is required to begin before or remain after a scheduled shift to perform preparatory work, the employee must receive minimum wage for each hour dedicated to preparatory work.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires employees to receive minimum wage for any time spent doing preparatory work before or after a scheduled shift.
