SENATE AMENDMENT "B " to H.P. 1392, L.D. 1893, Bill, "An Act to Conform the Maine Tip Credit to the Federal Tip Credit"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 28 and 29 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "section or the tip credit allowed under federal law, whichever is greater." and inserting in its place the following: 'section. An employer's tip credit may not exceed 50% of the minimum hourly wage established by this section or the tip credit allowed under federal law, whichever is greater, if a service employee earns more than \$500 a month in tips.'


