HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 10, "Joint Order to Adopt Joint Rules"

Amend the Joint Order in Joint Rule 13 in that part designated "Legislative Committees" by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'There shall be no more than 17 Joint Standing Committees which shall be appointed as follows at the commencement of the first regular session, viz:

- On Agriculture
- On Appropriations and Financial Affairs
- On Banking and Insurance
- On Business and Economic Development
- On Criminal Justice
- On Education and Cultural Affairs
- On Human Resources
- On Inland Fisheries and Wildlife
- On Judiciary
- On Labor
- On Legal and Veterans Affairs
- On Marine Resources
- On Natural Resources, Conservation and Forestry
- On State and Local Government
- On Taxation
- On Transportation
- On Utilities and Energy'
