8	Senate. The first named House member shall be the House Chair. The first named Senate member shall be the Senate Chair. The
10	committee shall make recommendations to the House and the Senate. The committee shall be responsible to review the charge
12	of each standing and select committee of the 117th Legislature. The committee shall be authorized to conduct surveys and hold
14	in-house public hearings. The committee shall report to the Legislative Council by May 15, 1995 on its recommendations. The
16	report shall include, but not be limited to the following: number of committees, committee workloads, restructuring of committees
