HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to S.P. 10, "Joint Order to Adopt Joint Rules"

Amend the Joint Order by adding after Joint Rule 13-B the following:

'13-C. Legislative Committee on Total Quality Management and Rules. There is a Legislative Committee on Total Quality Management and Rules. A minimum of 6 House members shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House. A minimum of 6 Senate members shall be appointed by the President of the Senate. The first-named House member shall be the House Chair. The first-named Senate member shall be the Senate Chair. The Legislative Council may designate nonlegislative members of the committee. Upon agreement by the appointed or designated committee members, other members may be appointed to the committee.

A permanent subcommittee on rules is established. Membership of the subcommittee is limited to the first 6 House members appointed by the Speaker of the House to serve on the full committee and the first 6 Senate members appointed by the President of the Senate to serve on the full committee. The subcommittee shall consider recommendations to change the Joint Rules. Any recommendations to change the rules by the subcommittee must be reported directly to the Legislature.

The committee may establish other subcommittees as necessary. Membership of the subcommittees is upon agreement of the appointed or designated members.'
