2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1310-U**, as amended by PL 1995, c. 656, Pt.
A, §26, is further amended by inserting after the 2nd paragraph a
new paragraph to read:

6 Municipalities may enact standards stricter than state
8 standards regulating sewer or septic sludge as long as the
10 requirements of section 1305 are met.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill allows all municipalities to enact stricter
standards regulating sewer or septic sludge as long as they
16 comply with state law regarding the disposal of solid waste
created within the municipality.
