SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 18, L.D. 16, Bill, "An Act to Allow Municipalities to Advertise Public Legal Notices in Weekly Papers"


Amend the amendment in that part designated "§601." in the first paragraph in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 41 and 42 in amendment) by striking out the following: "must be published and printed in whole or in part in this State;" and inserting in its place the following: '~~must be published and printed in whole or in part in this State,~~'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§601." in the first paragraph in the 6th line (page 1, line 43 in amendment) by striking out the following: ";" and inserting in its place the following: ' + ' '

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§601." in the first paragraph in the 7th line (page 1, line 44 in amendment) by striking out the following: "at a post office in this State" and inserting in its place the following: '~~at a post office in this State~~'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirements that in order to be qualified as a medium for the publication of legal notices, legal advertising and other matter required by law to be published in a newspaper, the newspaper be published, printed and mailed in this State.

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
