COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 18, L.D. 16, Bill, "An Act to Allow Municipalities to Advertise Public Legal Notices in Weekly Papers"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Expand the Options for Municipalities in Advertising Public Legal Notices'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §601, as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c. 667, §1, is amended to read:

§601. Publication of legal notices and advertising

To be qualified as a medium for the publication of legal notices, legal advertising and other matter required by law to be published in a newspaper, a newspaper, unless otherwise ordered by the court in the proceedings, must be published and printed in whole or in part in this State; must be printed in the English language; must be entered as 2nd class postal matter in the United States mails at a post office in this State and must have general circulation in the vicinity where the notice is required to be published. Any legal notice, legal advertising or other matter required by law to be published in a newspaper shall must appear in all editions of that newspaper.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a municipality may publish legal notices in a newspaper if:
