22	This bill allows school units to clarify the relationship
	between the warrant articles authorizing specific line item

expenditures and the warrant articles summarizing the 3 major

types of expenditures. The purpose of the bill is also to avoid confusion that arises when voters approve specific line items but

not the overall budget, or vice versa, leaving the status of the school budget unclear. The bill also corrects a cross-reference.

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
