## **'FISCAL NOTE**

This bill may reduce prosecutions for Class E crimes. If jail sentences are reduced, the savings to the counties are estimated to be \$83.78 per day per prisoner. These savings do not affect reimbursement by the State. The reduction in the number of prosecutions that would have resulted in a jail sentence and the resulting savings to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.

The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from 14 reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the 16 court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will realize some minor savings from reduced enforcement costs.'

## **SUMMARY**

This amendment removes a provision from the bill that proposed to allow a hunter to erect and use a portable tree stand without the permission of the landowner. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
