COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 29, L.D. 27, Bill, "An Act to Broaden the Requirements for Special Veterans Registration Plates"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 11th line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~military~~ form" and inserting in its place the following: 'military form or other official form issued by the Federal Government'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Expanding the former prisoners of war license plate program will result in a minor reduction of Highway Fund revenues and a minor cost of producing the plates. The loss of revenue and additional costs associated with the bill are minimal and can be absorbed within the Department of the Secretary of State's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds a requirement that a civilian interned as a prisoner of war submit an official form issued by the Federal Government that certifies that the person is a former prisoner of war to qualify for special veterans registration plates. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
