COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 33, L.D. 31, Bill, "An Act to Require That a Vacancy in the Office of Sheriff Be Filled by an Appointee from the Same Political Party"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§371-B.~~" in the indented paragraph by striking out all of the first sentence (page 1, lines 7 to 10 in L.D.)

SUMMARY

This amendment removes language describing the causes of vacancies in the office of sheriff from the bill.
