COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 34, L.D. 32, Bill, "An Act to Grandfather Ambulance Attendants from Additional Rulemaking"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "September" and inserting in its place the following: 'August' and in the last line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "September" and inserting in its place the following: 'August'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "September" and inserting in its place the following: 'August'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The additional costs associated with maintaining an additional level of licensing can be absorbed by the Department of Public Safety utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment changes the retroactivity date to August 30, 1996 and adds a fiscal note.
