Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 **Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §85, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

6 **5. Ambulance attendants grandfathered.** An ambulance
8 attendant having a license under this section on September 30,
10 1996 is grandfathered for the purposes of licensing and is not
12 subject to rules affecting the licensing of ambulance attendants
14 adopted by the board after September 30, 1996.

16 **Sec. 2. Retroactivity.** This Act applies retroactively to
18 September 30, 1996.
