COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 35, L.D. 33, "An Act to Change the Selection Process and Qualifications for State Auditor"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "**§241.**" by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 1, lines 8 to 37 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

26 'The State Auditor shall-be is the head of the Department of Audit, -as-heretofore-established. If the Legislature fails to confirm the appointment, the office becomes vacant until a gubernatorial nominee is confirmed by the Legislature to fill the office during the unempired term. During any vacancy, the duties of the office must be performed by the deputy auditor as provided in section 242.'

10 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "§241-A." in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 45 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "quadrennial <u>septennial</u> election" and inserting in its place the following: 'quadrennial 14 election <u>appointment</u>'

16 Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "§242." in the 2nd paragraph in the 3rd line (page 2, line 13 in 18 L.D.) by inserting after the following: "accountant" the following: 'or a certified internal auditor'

SUMMARY

24 This amendment adds language allowing a certified internal auditor to serve as State Auditor, removes the language 26 increasing the State Auditor's term from 4 years to 7 years and limiting service to one term and makes other provisions of law 28 consistent with these changes.
