COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 36, L.D. 34, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Change the Process for the Selection of the State Treasurer"

Amend the resolution by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Change the Process for the Selection of the Treasurer of State'

Further amend the resolution in Section 1. in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 10 and 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "voting in convention by a joint ballot of Senators and Representatives"

Further amend the resolution by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the First Regular Session of the 118th Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes reference to voting by ballot and adds a fiscal note to the resolution.
