Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13203 is enacted to read:
\$13203. Continued contracts; exempt
A school that has only one teacher is exempt from the requirements of section 13201.
SUMMARY
This bill exempts a school that has only one teacher the requirement that they must either renew a teacher contract or
fire that teacher after the 2-year probationary period.
