COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 17, L.D. 42, Bill, "An Act to Allow Veterans to Get Vanity Veteran License Plates"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

	<b>1997-98</b>	<b>1998-99</b>
<b>REVENUES</b>		
Highway Fund	\$2,775	\$5,550

Allowing veterans to obtain vanity veteran license plates will increase Highway Fund revenue by \$2,775 and \$5,550 in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively. This estimate assumes that 2.5% of the veterans currently participating in the veteran plate program will begin to participate in the vanity option for veteran license plates each year during the 1998-1999 biennium. After the first 2 years, additional revenue generated above \$5,550 will be insignificant since additional participation in the vanity option for veteran license plates will be offset by nonrenewals.'
