

An Act to Allow Veterans to Get Vanity Veteran License Plates.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §523, sub-§4** is enacted to read:

6 4. Veterans vanity plates. Upon request and as provided by
8 section 453, the Secretary of State shall issue veterans
10 registration plates that are also vanity plates. Veterans
12 registration vanity plates are issued in accordance with this
14 section and section 453. The annual service fee of \$15 for
16 vanity plates is credited to the Highway Fund.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 Current law gives Purple Heart medal recipients the ability
18 to get vanity Purple Heart registration plates. This bill gives
20 those veterans who, under current law, have the option to get
veteran-designated registration license plates the further option
of getting vanity veteran registration plates.
