2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §421, sub-§§4 and 5,** as amended by PL 1989,
c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, are further amended to read:

6 **4. Attachment of real estate.** For the attachment of real
estate at the registry of deeds, \$4 \$16;

10 **5. Attachment of personal property; replevin.** For the
attachment of personal property or for the service of a writ of
replevin, \$6 \$16, and \$2 \$10 more for each hour after the first
12 required for the service;
