22	Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of subparagraph (40) (page 1, lines 21 to 25 in L.D.) and inserting
24	in its place the following:
26	'(40) Services provided by a dance instructor to
28	<u>students of a dance studio when there is a contract</u> between the instructor and the studio under which the
30	<u>instructor's services are not offered exclusively to</u> <u>the studio, the studio does not control the scheduling</u>
32	<u>of the days and times of classes other than beginning and end dates, the instructor is paid by the class and</u>
34	not on an hourly or salary basis, the compensation rate is the result of negotiation between the instructor and
36	the studio and the instructor is given the freedom to develop the curriculum.'
