2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6726** is enacted to read:

6 **§6726. Drag limits from Stanley Point to Schoodic Point**

8 Notwithstanding section 6722, it is unlawful to fish for or  
10 take scallops from April 15th to November 30th north of a line  
12 from Stanley Point in Steuben to Schoodic Point in Winter Harbor.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill prohibits the taking of scallops from April 15th  
to November 30th north of a line from Stanley Point in Steuben to  
Schoodic Point in Winter Harbor.
