Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6726 is enacted to read:
§6726. Drag limits from Stanley Point to Schoodic Point
Notwithstanding section 6722, it is unlawful to fish for or
take scallops from April 15th to November 30th north of a line
from Stanley Point in Steuben to Schoodic Point in Winter Harbor.
SUMMARY
This bill prohibits the taking of scallops from April 15th
to November 30th north of a line from Stanley Point in Steuben to
Schoodic Point in Winter Harbor.
