### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §401, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1995, c. 645, Pt. B, §7 and affected by §24, is further amended to read:

Content of application. An application must contain information requested by the Secretary of State, including legal name, residence and address of the registrant, name of the insurer with whom the registrant has a liability insurance policy as required by section 402, current mileage of a motor vehicle, a brief description of the vehicle, the maker, identification number, the year of manufacture, and the type of motor fuel and, for trucks, truck-tractors and special mobile initial application equipment, the gross weight. An registration must be signed by the registered owner or the registered owner's legal representative. The Secretary of State shall keep initial applications on file until that registration is terminated.
