14 SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 39, 16 L.D. 64, Bill, "An Act to Provide Reimbursement to Counties for Persons Jailed on Probation Revocations"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 2nd indented 20 paragraph after the title the following:

22 'Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the last line (page 2, line 36 in L.D.) by 24 striking out the following: "and" and inserting in its place the following: 'and'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in paragraph B in the last 4 lines (page 2, lines 41 to 44 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or section 1206, if the defendant is sentenced pursuant to a probation revocation to a county jail, regardless of where the initial, unsuspended portion of the imprisonment occurred." and inserting in its place the following: '-; and'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 by 36 inserting after paragraph B the following:

38 C. Persons convicted of a Class A, B or C crime sentenced after September 1, 1997, to serve a term of imprisonment 40 pursuant to Title 17-A, section 1206, if the defendant is sentenced to a county jail.' '

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the Department of Corrections' obligation to reimburse counties for persons sentenced to a county jail pursuant to a probation revocation proceeding is limited to individuals who were originally sentenced for a Class A, B or C crime.
