COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 39, L.D. 64, Bill, "An Act to Provide Reimbursement to Counties for Persons Jailed on Probation Revocations"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble (page 1, lines 1 to 23 in L.D.).

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency clause (page 3, lines 23 and 24 in L.D.).

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Corrections may require additional General Fund appropriations beginning in fiscal year 1997-98 to provide reimbursement to county jails for persons sentenced pursuant to a probation revocation. The estimated cost is \$83.78 per day per prisoner. The total additional General Fund appropriations required each year can not be determined at this time.'
