36	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §833, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 623, §1, is amended to read:
38	3. Public hearing. The budget committee shall hold a public hearing in the county on the proposed budget before the
40	end of the county's fiscal year and before the final adoption of the budget. Notice of the hearing must be given in all

A. The budget adopted by the budget committee may be changed only by a majerity unanimous vote of the full board of county commissioners and—a-majority—vete—of—all—eleeted members—of—the—budget—committee. If the adopted budget is changed by the county commissioners, the budget committee may reject that change by a majority vote of its membership. Those actions are final and are not subject to further action by either the county commissioners or the budget committee.

Sec. 3. 30-A MRSA §833, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

5. Notice of meetings. All work sessions, workshops and other meetings on the budget conducted by the budget committee under this section must be open to the public and be preceded by publication of notice as provided for public hearings in subsection 3. In addition, the budget committee must provide notice of all work sessions, workshops and other meetings on the budget to municipal clerks, county commissioners and members of the York County legislative delegation as provided for public hearings in subsection 3.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires the notification of county commissioners and members of the York County legislative delegation of any budget committee public hearings, work sessions and other meetings. The additional costs of this state mandate will be minor. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. It authorizes the York County Commissioners to change the county budget adopted by the York County Budget Committee by unanimous vote of the 5 commissioners. If the commissioners change the budget committee's budget, the budget committee may override the change by a majority vote of the full committee. The amendment also requires notice of budget committee public hearings and all work

sessions, workshops and other meetings on the budget to be
published 14 days before the hearing and that notice be sent by
mail to the municipal clerks, county commissioners and
legislative delegation of York County 14 days before the
hearing. The amendment also adds a mandate preamble.
