2	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §833, sub-§4, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
4	623, §1, is amended to read:
6	A. The budget adopted by the budget committee may be changed only by a majority vote of the county commissioners
8	and-a-majority-vote-of-all-elected-members-of-the-budget committee. Those-actions-are <u>That action is</u> final and are
10	<u>is</u> not subject to further action by eitherthecounty commissioners-or the budget committee.
