

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §833, sub-§4, ¶A**, as enacted by PL 1993, c.  
623, §1, is amended to read:

6 A. The budget adopted by the budget committee may be  
8 changed only by a majority vote of the county commissioners  
and ~~a majority vote of all elected members of the budget~~  
10 ~~committee. These actions are~~ That action is final and are  
12 is not subject to further action by ~~either the county~~  
~~commissioners or~~ the budget committee.
