2	Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1913-A, sub-§1, ¶H, as enacted by PL 1981, c.
4	318, §3, is amended to read:
6	H. Signs bearing political messages relating to an election, primary or referendum, provided that these signs
8 .	may not be placed within the right-of-way prior to 6 weeks before the election, primary or referendum to which they
10	relate and must be removed by the candidate or political committee not later than one week thereafter. The signs may
12	not be larger than 14 inches by 22 inches.
