COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 57, L.D. 82, Bill, "An Act to Allow Field Testing of Unregistered Snowmobiles Repaired by Licensed Snowmobile Repair Shops"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

The licensure of snowmobile repair shops will increase annual General Fund revenue collected by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife by \$1,500 beginning in fiscal year 1997-98.

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will require additional General Fund appropriations of \$1,500 annually beginning in fiscal year 1997-98 to meet the constitutional requirement that appropriations to the department are at least equal to the undedicated revenues collected by the department.'

SUMMARY

This is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. This amendment adds an appropriation and a fiscal note to the bill.
