SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 57, L.D. 82, Bill, "An Act to Allow Field Testing of Unregistered Snowmobiles Repaired by Licensed Snowmobile Repair Shops"

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph B in subparagraph (3) in the last line (page 2, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph B in subparagraph (4) in the last line (page 2, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "employee." and inserting in its place the following: 'employee; and'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph B by inserting after subparagraph (4) the following:


'(5) Registration is not required to field test repairs to a snowmobile if the snowmobile is tested on the premises of the snowmobile repair shop when the snowmobile repair shop is open and the snowmobile is not owned by the snowmobile repair shop or any repair shop employee.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that registration of a snowmobile is not required to field test repairs to a snowmobile if the

snowmobile is tested on the premises of the snowmobile repair shop when the snowmobile repair shop is open and the snowmobile is not owned by the snowmobile repair shop or any repair shop employee.
