COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 59, L.D. 84, Bill, "An Act to Reduce the Meal Allowance for Legislators from \$32 to \$16"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund (\$152,694) (\$250,998)

Reducing the meal allowance for legislators from \$32 per day to \$16 per day will result in General Fund savings to the Legislature of \$152,694 in fiscal year 1997-98 and \$250,998 in fiscal year 1998-99. These amounts are deappropriated.
