

4 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1765, sub-§9**, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 402,
Pt. A, §180, is amended to read:

6 **9. Camper trailers.** Camper trailers, including slide-in
8 truck campers.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill includes slide-in truck campers as property
14 eligible for the trade in allowance credit. The tax levied would
be on the difference between the sale price of the purchased
16 property and the trade-in of the property taken in.
