COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 70, L.D. 95, Bill, "An Act Concerning Prisoner Participation in Public Works Projects"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the last line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "subsection 2." the following: 'The sentence runs consecutively with any other sentence.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in the 8th line (page 1, line 23 in L.D) by striking out the following: "one day" and inserting in its place the following: '\$5'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in the 9th line (page 1, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "sentences" and inserting in it place the following: 'fines'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that prisoners participating in public works projects for nonpayment of fines may reduce the fine by \$5 for every hour worked. It also states that a sentence imposed for nonpayment of fines runs consecutively with any other sentence.
