18 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H " to H.P. 73, L.D. 98, Bill, "An Act 20 Regarding Balances Remaining in General Purpose Aid for Local Schools"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15613, sub-§17 is enacted to read:

17. Unobligated balances. Unobligated balances from amounts appropriated for general purpose aid for local schools 30 may not lapse but must be redistributed to school administrative 32 units in the same fiscal year. The commissioner shall make the final determination of the total amount of unobligated funds and 34 must redistribute 75% of those funds to program costs and 25% of those funds to out-of-district placement costs. To redistribute 36 the 75% portion to the state share of program costs, the reduction percentage originally calculated for program costs pursuant to section 15603, subsection 26-A, paragraph F must be 38 reduced by an amount sufficient to distribute the 75% share. The reductions in these percentages apply to all program cost areas 40 except the transportation operating cost allocation.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Requiring that unobligated balances of appropriations within 6 General Purpose Aid for Local Schools account be the redistributed to school administrative units within the same fiscal year will reduce amounts that might otherwise be available 8 to offset future funding needs of General Purpose Aid for Local 10 Schools or other General Fund programs.'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that unobligated general purpose aid balances may not lapse, but must be redistributed during the same fiscal year. Seventy-five percent of unobligated balances must be applied to program costs and 25% to out-of-district placement. The 75% portion to be applied to the state share of program costs must be determined by recalculating the original reduction percentage calculation.
