Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §163-A, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 501, Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

1. Bill drafting. To furnish to the members of the Legislature the assistance of expert drafteman <u>drafters</u> qualified to aid the Legislature in the preparation of bills for introduction into the Legislature *f*.

A. In drafting bills, the drafters must underline new language that is not allocated to the Maine Revised Statutes and must italicize language that is being repealed, but appears in a different place in the law;

SUMMARY

This bill requires language that is not allocated to the 20 Maine Revised Statutes to be underlined and requires that language that is repealed but reappears elsewhere in the law be 22 italicized.
