

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13037 is enacted to read:

6 §13037. First aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation
certification

8 A person may not be certified as a teacher under this
10 chapter unless the person has a current certification in
12 cardiopulmonary resuscitation and basic first aid from an
organization acceptable to the department.

14 SUMMARY

16 This bill provides that in order to be certified as an
18 elementary or secondary school teacher, a person must have
current certification of training in cardiopulmonary
20 resuscitation and basic first aid.
