COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 77, L.D. 102, Bill, "An Act to Repeal the Mandatory Driver Education Course"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Eliminating the mandatory driver education course prior to licensure for persons under 17 years of age will reduce Highway Fund revenue by \$18,505 annually beginning in fiscal year 1997-98. This estimate is based on a 50% reduction in the collection of private and public driver school license fees and teacher license fees.'
