COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 85, L.D. 110, Bill, "An Act to Exempt the American Legion from Certificates of Title and Registration Fees"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Exempt Certain Loaned Federal Vehicles from Certificates of Title'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1, 2 and 3 and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §652, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1995, c. 250, §1, is further amended to read:

1. United States' vehicle. A vehicle owned by the Federal Government, unless it is registered in this State or, at the discretion of the Secretary of State, a vehicle owned by the Federal Government that is loaned to the State ~~or~~ a municipality ~~for forest-fire-control-activities~~ or a veterans' organization;

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The exemption of certain vehicles from title fees will result in insignificant reductions of Highway Fund revenues collected by the Secretary of State.'

This amendment strikes from the bill an exemption from registration fees for vehicles donated by the Federal Government to veterans' organizations. In addition, the amendment permits the Secretary of State to exempt from title and certificate of salvage requirements vehicles that are loaned by the Federal Government to veterans' organizations and municipalities. The amendment changes the bill title to reflect this change.

The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
