This bill amends the motor vehicle laws regarding auto

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requirement of a 10-day notice before cancellation of a policy, insurance companies provide the Secretary of State with a 10-day 2. notice before termination of a policy occurs by expiration. In either case the Secretary of State must demand proof of financial 4 responsibility under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29-A, section 1602, including notice of the penalties for failure to 6 provide proof. Under the terms of section 1602, subsection 2, failure to comply with the demand within 30 days will result in 8 the suspension of the person's license, of the registration of 10 the vehicle for which proof of insurance was not provided and of the right to apply for a license or registration.
